Dear Friends and Supporters. As the festive season approaches, we want to extend our heartfelt thanks to each and every one of you. Your generosity and commitment have transformed lives in Uganda this year. Together, we've achieved so much - here's a look at what your support has made possible this year

## **Nyakabungo Girls Boarding Secondary School**

- Sponsored 40 girls, giving them the gift of education and hope.
- Provided mosquito nets for all new students, protecting them from malaria.
- Supplied sanitary towels to all girls throughout the year, supporting dignity and health.
- Funded the sewing teacher, empowering girls with practical skills.
- Kept the arts department well equipped with supplies.
  - Installed a secure wire fence around the school and female staff house, ensuring safety





### **Ruth Memorial Nursery School**

- Provided 78 children with a safe, nurturing environment to learn and play.
- Repaired broken see-saws, bringing joy to playtime.
- Supplied stationery needs throughout the year.
- Provided soap and a hand washing area, promoting good hygiene.
- Enabled daily meals of rice, porridge, beans, and milk.





### **Nyakatare Health Centre**

- Provided 2 solar batteries for the baby incubator, saving newborn lives.
- Supplied a new operating table, improving care for mothers and babies.
- Installed secure fencing for the whole facility.
- Established a Samaritan fund for mothers unable to afford emergency Caesarean sections.
- Funded regular Community Health outreaches.







#### **Further Education Students**

- Supported 8 girls with tuition and development fees as they progress to university.
- Supplied laptops for their studies.
- Assisted with transport and other personal needs.









We are delighted that we have been able to do all of the above. The improvements to the school have encouraged more girls to enrol which is positive; however the increased numbers has highlighted the need for improved toilet and shower blocks and a main hall to accommodate everyone.
